Also, Greg Trenary and Joe Salyer are planning to take a mission team in the fall to western North Carolina to aid the victims of Hurricane Helene, which occurred in September of 2024. If you are interested in joining their team, please let Greg or Joe know. As the details are developed, we'll keep everyone posted.

It is exciting to see our body of believers looking "outward" instead of focusing only "inward".

RHC is financially supporting a young family, Josh and Rachel Herschner, in their International Mission Ministry in east Africa.

Lane Pugh, one of our young adults, recently went on an international mission trip to Spain. Lane recently shared in one of our Adult Sunday School Classes about the purpose and results of his trip.

Mission and ministry go hand in hand, and I'm excited to see our church expanding beyond our already excellent regular events. All can "plug in" at some level ... think Bless the Child, Shoebox Ministry, Bid for Help, and even more!

One of her favorite Scripture verses is Colossians 3:17, "And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him."



Baptism

On August 17th and September 7th Round Hill Church will have a service of baptism at Cedar Creek Christian Camp. Please see Pastor Doug or Pastor Roy if you're interested in being baptized.

Jesus told his disciples to "...go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit...". Jesus gave a command, not a suggestion.

So what is baptism? The authors of the New Testament wrote in the universal language of the day, Koine Greek. The Greek word used in scripture was "baptizo", meaning immerse, submerge, dip or wash. Round Hill certainly teaches the method of "going under", "dunking", "being covered" or similar wording. A person that desires being baptized gets completely wet!

So what is baptism? Baptism is a command given to us by Jesus as a way for us as believers to acknowledge our faith and belief by undergoing this public demonstration. It is an outward and visible sign of our inward spiritual faith and commitment.

So what is baptism? It is an act of obedience that provides us a demonstration of God's washing away our sins. This gift is made possible through Jesus dying on the cross to take away our sins. When someone is baptized, they are symbolically dying to oneself (going under the water) and rising as a new creation and into a new life in the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit (coming up out of the water). Just as Jesus died and was resurrected, we also symbolically have that experience when we go through our own baptism.

Baptism shares with your family, friends, church and the world that you have been made new in Christ, you are a new creation by your faith, you publicly state your commitment to your faith.

As your Pastor, I am not eliminating the value of your baptism when you were a baby

or child. It is evident that as adult believers (you) become capable of making your own decision on your faith journey, and in some cases the decision is made to want to be baptized as an adult. We're glad to have that conversation with you if you are interested.







Well after over 12 years of good service, the church multifunctional printer has decided it was tired just before Vacation Bible School. A loaner copier was secured until the Facilities Committee could go thru the process of bidding and pricing a new multifunctional printer. The Church Board approved the purchase of a new machine from Tech Team Solutions at a cost of \$11,382.00. It was delivered in time to print this month's newsletter. We hope the new one will serve as many years as the last printer.

The Facilities Committee has been working on the youth area furnace room cleaning and organizing the area so we can have an organized storage area where supplies for the building can be found.

We do ask everyone to please be careful during events in the fellowship hall and pavilion. If you see water on the floor, please mop it up as soon as possible so we don't have a slip and fall hazard. We must watch where we put rugs and electrical extension cords, as they are trip and fall hazards for the people who are attending church events. We must keep all Fire Exits clear and open in case of emergency.

The key lock has been removed from the pavilion entrance door and replaced with a keyless entry door lock. All who need access to the door have their personal codes entered into the door lock. Note if you unlock the door it does not automatically lock, you must enter your code and press check mark to lock door back when finished using pavilion.

As we use the church building for more events, please put items back better than you found them and in proper place. Keeping things organized helps everyone find and know what is available for use in the church. Please return all keys back to Key Box when using a key to unlock doors.

The revised and upgraded church safety information cards, are now in the back of church pews. We have developed a safety handout brochure that we will be distributing in the near future. Once we get the brochures handed out, we will be having some safety informational classes for our church congregation. If you have any interest in being a part of the safety team please see Rocky Keplinger.

The Blood Pressure checks the 1st and 3rd Sunday's of the month are going well.

Every Sunday, we continue to see new faces visiting the Round Hill Church, what a blessing to have. The Church Board and Facilities committee are continuing monitor church attendance and activities as we grow, to make necessary changes for our church family needs.
