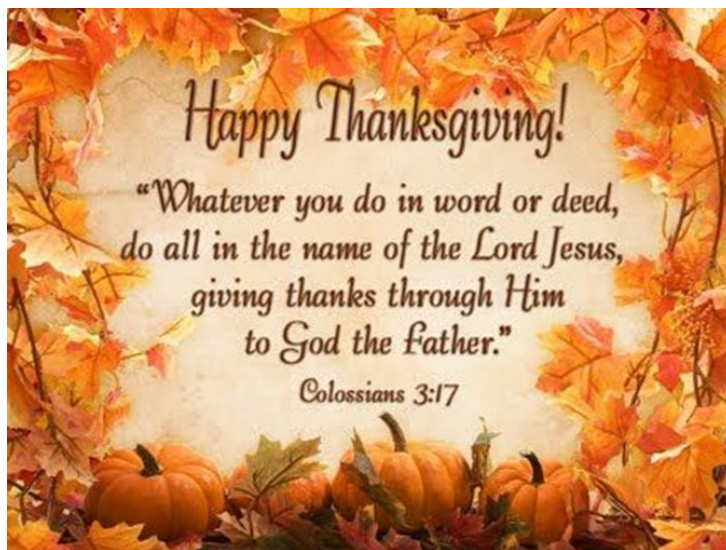

RHC Mission Trip to Boone, North Carolina

Our Mission Team Coordinator, Greg Trenary, has announced that we will be taking a team of adults (maximum 10) to Boone, North Carolina. RHC will be coordinating with Samaritan’s Purse and working on long standing projects in the areas of western North Carolina hardest hit by Hurricane Helene in 2024.

Our team will drive down on Sunday, January 4, 2026 and depart back to Winchester on the afternoon of Friday, January 9th.

Samaritan’s Purse requires an application to be completed in advance of the mission trip. All Mission Team expenses will be covered by the church. Samaritan’s Purse will provide meals while on-site and the only thing needed by our team is bedding and a pillow.

Most people don't see the church attic (which is a good thing) but work has started on cleaning out old stuff in attic that hasn't been used in years, plus it is a safety hazard. As the weather gets cooler we hope to finish this project. Jeanette and Josh Shable have been working hard on this, sorting thru VBS and other items that were stored in the attic. The items that we need to keep are being organized in the attic and pavilion, let's try to keep them organized!

There is some construction going on around the cell tower that the church doesn't own. Please be careful around that area until the construction is completed.

We do ask everyone to please be careful during events in the fellowship hall and pavilion, if you see water on the floor please mop it up, as soon as possible so we don't have a slip and fall hazard. We must watch where we put rugs and electrical extension cords, as they are trip and fall hazards for the people who are attending church events. We must keep all Fire Exits clear and open in case of emergency.

As we use the church building for more events, please put items back better than you found them and in proper place. Keeping things organized helps everyone find and know what is available for use in the church. Please return all keys back to Key box when using a key to unlock doors.

The revised and upgraded church safety information cards, are now in the back of church pews. We have developed a safety handout brochure that we will be distributing in the near future. Once we get the brochures handed out, we will be having some safety informational classes for our church congregation.
