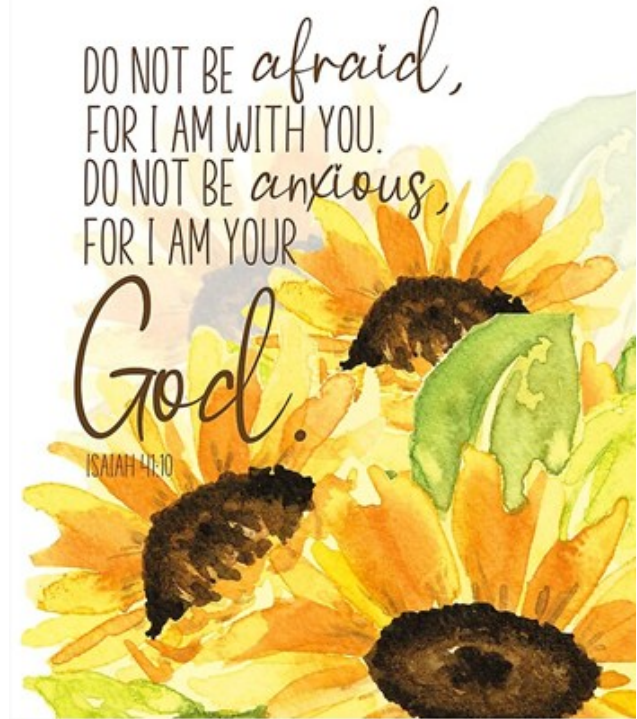

**Inviting Others: A Simple Way

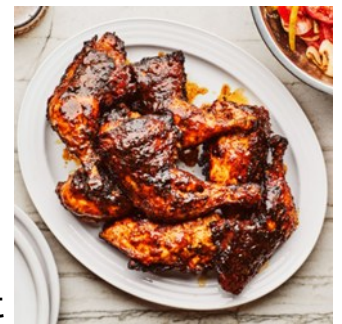
