For March, the actual regular offering was \$41,486, budget was \$35,140, representing 118% of the budgeted amount received. Giving for January–March was \$97,974 Actual, \$91,364 Budget, representing 107% of the budgeted amount received.

### Mission Meals!

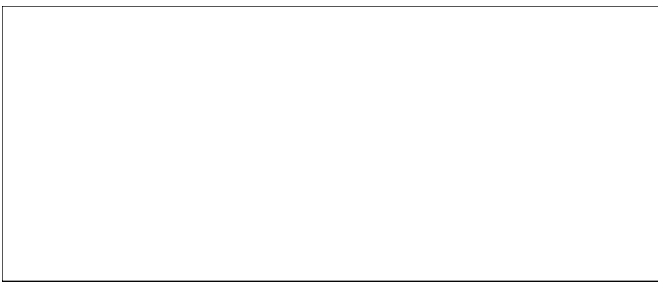


We will be packing lunches for the Freedge on Sunday, May 18th immediately following Sunday School.
