**Resurrection Sunday

During our Worship Services on March 30th, we celebrated Communion and focused on three words; Reflect, Repent, and Rejoice.

Reflect - on Jesus' sacrifice, His suffering, His death for each of us.

Repent - look inward to anything that might be in your life that offends the Lord, confess your sin and then turn away from that sin.

Rejoice - celebrate and thank God for Jesus dying on the cross. He gives us reason to celebrate, so give thanks and praise His name for that gift and promise of eternal life.

Giving Report

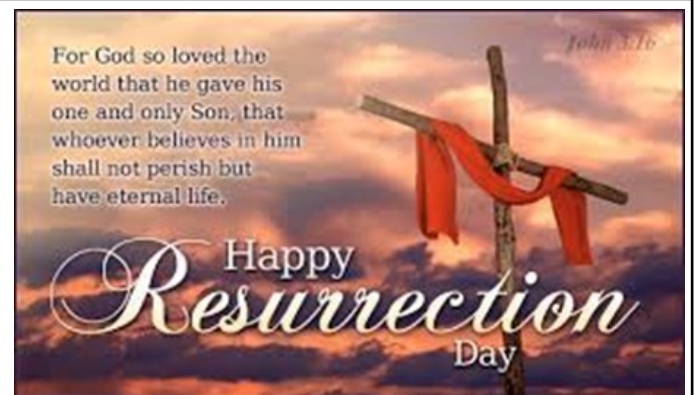
For February, the actual regular offering was \$28,320, budget was \$28,112, representing 101% of the budgeted amount received.

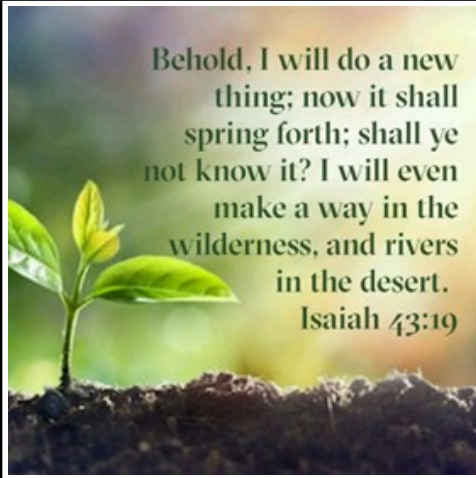

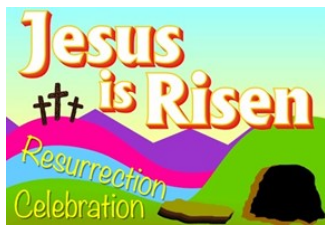
**Want to get to know people?

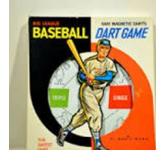
